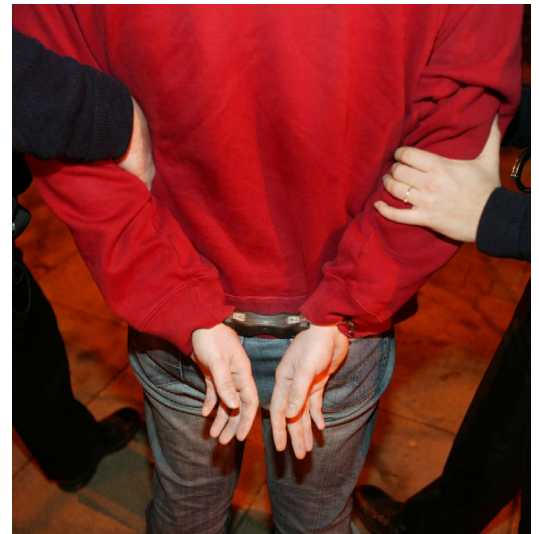
To report ASB that's not related to council housing, please use Nottingham City Council's online reporting service: www.nottinghamcity.gov.uk/report-it.
